Skills to be developed:

In addition to ongoing pedagogical instruction, participants in the program will develop numerous practical teaching skills including:

- Working one-on-one and in small groups with students in a variety of subjects
- Assisting teachers in the classroom during lessons
- Helping with lesson planning
- Teaching short lessons
- Marking
- Assisting students with special learning needs
- Supervising activities
- Other school-related tasks
